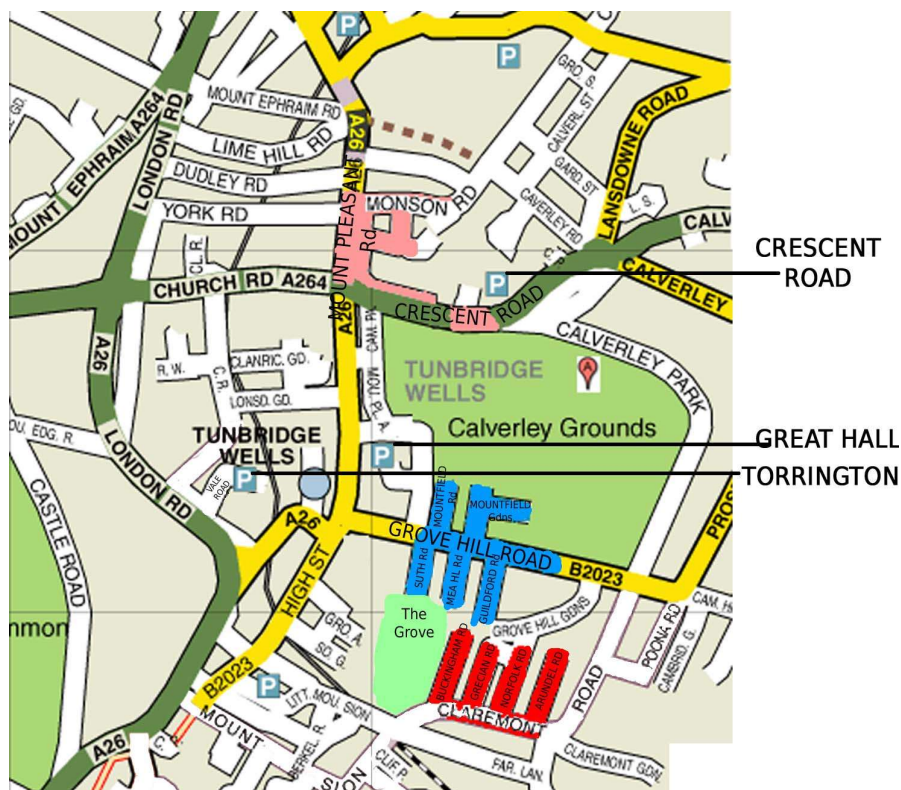


How to Find Us (Parking in Tunbridge Wells is a problem.....)

We're at the Pin marked A in Calverley Grounds. The Blue Circle is the Station.

Crescent Road Car Park (postcode TN1 2LU) is the closest and if you park there leave by the vehicle entrance to Crescent Road. Immediately cross the road and the entrance to the Catholic Church should be visible to your right. A few yards before this on your left you will see a stone archway.

Pass through the arch and walk straight ahead. The entrance to Calverley Grounds is to your right via a footpath just before the (gated) entrance to Calverley Park road. Follow the footpath for 30 yards, then turn left onto a path to the left of a basketball court. A few yards straight ahead you will see our clubhouse.



Monday-Saturday Parking:

FREE parking is available from 11am onwards in the roads around Claremont Road (**RED**), about a 10 minute walk away, with alleyways from these roads into The Grove and Grove Hill Road. There is an entrance into Calverley Grounds in Mountfield Gardens (**BLUE**).

Car Parking charges are as follows, but note that the pay machines **ONLY TAKE COINS**:

Sunday Parking:

Car parks still normally make a charge, but only between 10am and 4pm. The Torrington Rail section is, however, **FREE**.

Single yellow lines and parking bays on all roads, such as residents parking, are currently free; but please check the signs. Unfortunately Crescent Road and adjacent roads are mostly double-yellow lines and their parking spaces are often full anyway, but you could try the roads in **PINK** on the map.

The **most likely places** with spaces are on the opposite side of the park from the club, off Grove Hill Road in **BLUE** – try Mountfield Gardens first. There are entrances into the park in both Mountfield Road and Mountfield Gardens.
